

Additional to the Highways Issues Log the following are reports of recent activity.

## **Highways Updates**

## 1. Woolton Hill Road - broken sign (@Blind Man's Gate junction)

Regrettably notwithstanding confirmation of pending replacement by B&BDC, this sign has still not been replaced over a year since its initial damage and loss.

#### 2. Tile Barn Row – potholes on crown of road

Patching works have been undertaken, sadly with adjacent smaller areas of damage left unattended as the prime time of year for further potholes to develop approaches.

#### 3. Traffic Calming Bollard – Woolton Hill Road

Broken bollard on traffic calming curb incursion has now been replaced.

## 4. Roadworks Warning Signs etc

Following further communications both with HCC Highways and Cllr Thacker, a variety of redundant traffic warning signs have at last been collected from around the parish.

Councillors are again asked to inform GD of any further redundant signs/bollards etc awaiting removal (preferably with a pic) so that combined reports can be submitted to HCC Highways requesting collection.

### Councillors to inform GD of any uncollected signage.

## **Speed Indicator Device (SID)**

Due to road maintenance activities affecting safe parking of the service vehicle, the recent placement of the SID at its scheduled location was not possible. It was therefore advanced to the next location and the rota adjusted accordingly. Occasional disruption occurs to data recording resulting in not every location being routinely reported.
