Additional to the Highways Issues Log the following are reports of recent activity.

Highways Updates

1. Trade Street/Tile Barn Row/ Woolton Hil Road Jct & Brownies Corner - broken finger signs.

Following acceptance by EWPC of the quote received from Ultimate Signs for £690 + vat. Restorative work has been completed to both signs. Cllr Thacker has been approached for any funding support

available to cover this expenditure which would not normally be a PC outlay.









2. **Woolton Hill Road - broken sign** (@Blind Man's Gate junction)

Despite confirmation received from B&BDC that it is listed for replacement, this still awaits the next batch of street name sign installations.

3. Tile Barn Row - potholes on crown of road

Despite system HCC system statement that works are to be scheduled no activity to date other than white highlighting of the holes which sadly continue to extend.

4. Traffic Calming Bollard - Woolton Hill Road

Broken bollard reported for replacement but has since been replaced by a temporary traffic alert sign pending replacement of the former bollard.

5. Roadworks Warning Signs etc

A variety of redundant traffic warning signs have been accumulating around the parish, having failed to be collected after the activities to which they refer are long completed. The large yellow-sign warning of works on the Woolton Hill – Ball Hill Road has now been removed following its report, however the signs in Trade Street reported on the same ticket remain, and have been

reported for collection once more.

Councillors are asked to inform GD of any further redundant signs/bollards etc awaiting removal (preferably with a pic) so that a combined report can be submitted to HCC Highways.

Councillors to inform GD of any uncollected signage.



Speed Indicator Device (SID)

Due to road maintenance activities affecting safe parking of the service vehicle, the recent placement of the SID at its scheduled location was not possible. It was therefore advanced to the next location and the rota adjusted accordingly.
